Easy Print Ring Sizer
*Sizes \& dimensions are approximate.

Make sure your printer is set to 100-percent. Do not reduce the print size in any way, shape or form! You can verify that this ring sizer was printed correctly by measuring it with a ruler; it should measure $31 / 2$ inches long from "A" down towards "B", as shown here.
To open up the Print Dialog Box - press CTRL+P for PC users or COMMAND + P for Mac.

## OPTION 1: Measuring your finger.

1. Cut out the ring sizer.
2. Make a slit for Slot "A".
3. Wrap it around your finger where you want the ring band, making sure that numbers are facing out.
4. Put tab "B" through Slot "A"until the sizer is snug around your finger. Make sure to allow size space for your knuckle when sizing this so you can slip the ring on and off.
5. The number that aligns with Slot " $A$ " will be your ring size.
6. If the number is between two numbers on sizer, your ring size is a half size.

For Example: Your measurement falls between 6 and 7, then your ring size is $6 \mathbf{1 / 2}$.
TIP: To make sure you get the size right, measure your finger at the beginning of the day and adjust accordingly. It's better to be safe than sorry when it comes down to jewelry purchases!


## OPTION 2: Measuring a ring that already fits.

1. Get a ring that you know already fits the intended finger.
2. Place that ring on top of the circle below, find the circle that matches the rings outside edge.

Comfort Fit Ring Tip: If the ring is a comfort fit design, match circles to the contoured edge of the inner surface of the ring.
